Create a post for your students welcoming them to Clanbeat. Our teachers suggest adding a fun photo to your first post.

5 MINUTES

Post some of these questions

What was your favorite moment for last term and why? What would you like to do with your class in 2021?
And / or any other question you think would be meaningful for your class.

In the class:

1

10 MINUTES

Ask your students to download the Clanbeat app (they do not need to register via the website). Follow in-app instructions on how to invite your students.

2

10 MINUTES

Ask students to fill in their profile choosing their interest + bucket list items thinking about 2021 and further.

3

10 MINUTES

Ask students to answer the questions under Q&A in the Shared Feeds screen.

4

5 MINUTES

Give the students an opportunity to check their peers' interests and bucket list items to increase the sense of community and belonging in the Community screen.

5

10 MINUTES

Ask students to write a reflection on their profile and share this with the teacher:

Reflection: What have you learned about yourself this school year? How do you feel about last term? How can we make 2021 the best year for you?

After the class




The teacher can go over all the answers to the questions and read reflections from each student -> give them feedback and kind wishes for this and following term
